The 2015 HIA-CSR Home of the Year has been won by Paul Clout Building & Design

A gala dinner was held on Friday 27 November at the Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre to announce the 2015 HIA-CSR Queensland Region Housing Awards.

To name only a few of HIA's major award winners - Queensland Professional Builder Awards were awarded to RedKem Constructions for Small Builder, Bold Properties for Medium Builder and Plantation Homes for Major Builder recognising their outstanding business achievement among Australia's home builders.

The 2015 HIA QLD Interior Design, Kitchen & Bathroom winner, was awarded for a luxurious home designed by Ultraspace and built by Stewart Homes, which was also awarded Brisbane Custom Built Homes valued over \$2 million for a home was luxuriously organic in both design and finish selection with a touch of high end glamour.
